INDICATIONS

- Confirmed hypoglycemia
- Suspected hypoglycemia in a known diabetic when a point-of-care glucose (POCG) measurement is not available

CONTRAINDICATIONS

ROUTE (WORK SCOPE)	INITIAL DOSE	REPEAT DOSE
INTRANASAL ¹ (EMR & ABOVE)	Greater than 20 kg - 1 mg	Once in 10 - 15 minutes if required
	Less than 20 kg - 0.5 mg	
INTRAMUSCULAR / INTRAVENOUS (PCP & ABOVE)	Greater than 20 kg - 1 mg	
	Less than 20 kg - 0.5 mg	
INTRAOSSEOUS (ICP & ABOVE)	Greater than 20 kg - 1 mg	
	Less than 20 kg - 0.5 mg	

NOTES

- 1. During the COVID pandemic IN administration requires extended PPE.
- 2. Administer IV/IO by slow push over 60 seconds.
- 3. Glucagon may cause significant nausea. Consider co-administration of antinauseant.
- 4. Ensure that the patient is eating or receives oral glucose / intravenous dextrose.
