INDICATIONS

• Severe anxiety or agitation that is interfering with, or may interfere with, the management and safe transport of the patient

WARNINGS

ABSOLUTE CONTRAINDICATIONS:

- Hypersensitivity to lorazepam
- Hypotension / hypoperfusion / shock
- · Respiratory depression
- Central nervous system depression

ADMINISTRATION	
ORAL / SUBLINGUAL	PCP / ICP / ACP

ADULTS:

- 1 to 2 mg
- Repeat once in 15 to 30 minutes if required

ADOLESCENTS:

- 1 mg
- Repeat once in 15 to 30 minutes if required

NOTES

1. Benzodiazepines may have more pronounced respiratory and central nervous system effects in the elderly, especially if frail or compromised. Consider the lower dose in patients over 75 years of age.
