ERS HIGH ALERT MEDICATION (A03)

INDICATIONS

- Rate control for stable atrial fibrillation / flutter (AF)
- Stable supraventricular tachycardia (SVT) refractory to, or recurring after, adenosine

WARNINGS

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

- Hypersensitivity to metoprolol
- Wide QRS complex ²
- Second or third degree heart block
- Hypotension or compensated hypoperfusion
- Decompensated heart failure
- Cardiogenic shock
- Cocaine overdose

USE WITH CAUTION:

- Asthma / chronic obstructive pulmonary disease
- History of sinus node dysfunction or first degree heart block
- Recent administration of verapamil or diltiazem
- Compensated heart failure
- Myasthenia gravis

ADMINISTRATION		
INTRAVENOUS (INTRAOSSEOUS)	ACP	

ADULTS:

- Administer 2.5 to 5 mg by slow push over 2 minutes
- Repeat every 5 minutes as required
- Max total dose = 15 mg

NOTES

1. A wide QRS complex with SVT or AF may indicate pre-excitation with an accessory pathway. Administration of atrioventricular node (AVN) blocking medications may result in life-threatening ventricular arrhythmias.
