Step	Action	
Document all maintenance performed on Centrifuge Maintenance Log		
Daily Maintenance		
1	Visually inspect the rotor, buckets, lids, caps and tube adapters/inserts	
2	Perform Hydraulic Lid Check (if applicable; some models will not have hydraulic lid). Ensure that when lifted the lid stays open and does not fall or slam closed	
Weekly Maintenance		
1	Wipe inside and outside surfaces of centrifuge, including rotor, with Oxivir wipes	
2	Remove buckets, lids and tube adapters/inserts from centrifuge; remove the O-rings from the buckets	
3	Wearing gloves, wash the buckets, lids, O-rings and tube adapters/inserts with mild detergent (Liquinox phosphate free detergent) solution; a soft nylon brush may be used to clean the tube adapters/inserts	
4	Rinse buckets, lids, O-rings and tube adapters/inserts thoroughly with water; ensure all parts are thoroughly dry before re-assembling	
5	Lubricate O-rings with vacuum grease and place on bucket	
6	Saturate a lint free tissue with manufacturer recommended oil and lubricate the contact areas between the buckets and pins as well as lubricating the pins and sockets	
7	Replace the buckets
