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Step	Action		
1	A primary leak-proof container is place in a secondary leak-proof container. NOTE: Cytotoxic samples obtained from patients who have received cytotoxic medication in the last 48 hours MUST be labelled with Cytotoxic label and packaged in its own separate secondary container. (zip-lock)	Primary containers	Secondary Container Ziplock bag with pouch
2	If there are liquid specimens, absorbent pad(s) MUST be placed in between the primary and secondary containers. Multiple blood samples must be package as per each individual collection with the accompanying requisition in the pouch provided.	White Absorbent Material	SPECIAL AND
3	The secondary container(s) are placed in a rigid outer packaging container to contain and protect samples. Place an ice pack at the bottom of the shipping container to keep refrigerated samples cool during transport. Room temperature specimens must be packaged separately with no ice pack. Add hot pack during colder months. Fill empty space with packing material to avoid samples from getting tossed around in transport.
