Revision to the Massive Transfusion Protocol

On August 28th, 2023, the former Massive Transfusion Protocol (MTP) will now be known as the Massive Hemorrhage Protocol (MHP) at Health Sciences Center and St. Boniface Hospital. With this name change come changes to the protocol. The changes for each facility can be found on the Transfusion Manitoba web page (<u>healthproviders.sharedhealthmb.ca/transfusion</u>). Committees from both facilities used a provincial framework to develop site specific MHP protocols that have brought alignment to all MHP's within Manitoba.
