Breast Cancer Diagnostic & Surgery Pathway	Timeline
1. Primary care orders diagnostic imaging or refers to diagnostic specialist	Within 1 day of patient visit
2. Diagnostic Mammogram / Ultrasound	Within 7 days of ordered test
3. Biopsy	Within 14 days of mammogram / ultrasound
4. Full Pathology Reporting / Surgical Consultation	Within 14 days of biopsy
5. a) First Surgery	Within 30 days of Surgical Consult
b) Post-Operative Appointment	Within 21 days of Surgery
c) Referral to Medical and/or Radiation Oncology for Adjuvant Treatment & Staging Scans Ordered	At Post-op appointment (results of staging scans within 14 days of ordering)

6. a) Referral Sent for Neoadjuvant Consult & Staging Scans Ordered	At Surgical Consultation (results of staging scans within 14 days of ordering)
b) Surgical Discussion Scheduled	At end of neoadjuvant treatment
