| Reason for Change | To align with additions and changes made by Manitoba Health to their Primary Care Quality Indicators Guide. Manitoba Health updated this guide in consultation with the Manitoba Primary Care Indicator Advisory Committee (MPAC) to reflect changes to primary care best practices and to support family physician tariff updates effective April 1, 2024 (Family Medicine Plus). |
| Implications of not implementing change | <p>Providing care based on Manitoba's PCQIs and submission of the Primary Care Data Extract (PCDE) are mandatory for primary care clinics participating in Manitoba's Home Clinic initiative. Submission of the PCDE also supports Family Medicine Plus tariff claims for eligible family physicians.</p> <p>Standard level EMRs - This change will be mandatory to maintain certification to the Primary Care Quality Indicator Reminders and Data Extract component.</p> <p>Integrated level EMRs – This change will be mandatory to maintain Integrated level certification.</p> |
