Definitions

Affiliate Health Corporation: A corporation, other than a health authority, under separate ownership or control, which owns, operates, and/or maintains the provision of health care services (*e.g., hospital, personal care home, clinic*).

Designated Bilingual Facilities, Programs, and Sites: A facility or program in which services are provided in both English and French, and whose primary language of operation is English.

Designated Bilingual Health Authority: A health authority that has the obligation of providing health services in French equivalent in quality, availability and accessibility to that offered in English and is required to actively offer services in both French and English.

Designated Francophone Facilities, Programs, and Sites: A facility or program in which services are provided in both English and French, or in French only, and whose primary language of operation is French.
