Do you have a Primary Care Provider joining or leaving your Home Clinic?

There are things to consider when clients choose to follow their Primary Care Provider to a new Home Clinic, such as:

- Coordinating the provider association dates
 - » Your Home Clinic Liaison can help facilitate this.
- Promptly updating the provider association dates in the Home Clinic Portal
 - » This will prevent unnecessary client enrolment remediation.

Coming soon - Enrolment status in eChart

Enrolment status in eChart will allow providers to view the Home Clinic where the client is enrolled, along with the Home Clinic contact number and the Primary Care Provider responsible for the client. This information will facilitate information sharing when providers from other sectors view the client's record in eChart as part of their normal process of providing care.

It is expected that providers will use this contact information to get in touch with Primary Care Providers regarding their client, when appropriate, for continuity of care.

Planning is underway to implement Enrolment Status in eChart later in 2018.
