Manitoba's Primary Care Quality Indicators

Manitoba Primary Care Quality Indicators (PCQI) are a set of evidence-based indicators developed in partnership with Manitoba physicians and other providers/specialists. They were originally based on the primary care indicators developed by the [Canadian Institute for Health Information \(CIHI\)](#) and have evolved over time to meet the needs of primary care in Manitoba. For example, new mental health and addictions management indicators are based on the CIHI recommended Screening, Brief Intervention and Referral (SBIR) approach. Primary care clinics participating in various programs and initiatives in Manitoba capture and track their indicator completeness. This enables them to regularly review patient care management to support practice reflection and continuous quality improvement. The PCQI data captured in EMRs are submitted to Manitoba Health, Seniors and Active Living through the Primary Care Data Extract. The PCQIs are regularly reviewed and revised by the Manitoba Primary Care Indicator Advisory Committee (MPAC). MPAC, comprised of primary care clinicians, program managers and other key stakeholders, provides input and advice regarding the development, implementation and evaluation of PCQIs across primary care settings in Manitoba.

Home Clinics: Did you know?

By using the Client Report located in the Clients Tab in the Home Clinic Portal you can find a list of:

- All passively enrolled patients to help prioritize which patients still require an active conversation
- All patients that are currently enrolled to your Home Clinic with no provider association to assist in any enrolment errors and any enrolment clean up
- Information about your enrolled patients that can be filtered by provider, enrolment method and "as of" enrolment date to help with a variety of enrolment tasks such as aligning the enrolment in the EMR to the Home Clinic Portal

Over 100 clinics in Manitoba have implemented the Home Clinic Enrolment Service

The Enrolment Service will provide the following benefits to Home Clinics:

- Improved accuracy and timeliness of enrolment
- Fewer enrolment rejections
- Timely validation of enrolment errors
- Up-to-date notifications of enrolment conflicts delivered to the EMR
- Elimination of manual entry of enrolment in the Home Clinic Portal
