

Enrolment Service

Enrolment Service is a eHealth_hub interface that provides the ability to enroll patients from within a Certified EMR. This service provides Home Clinics with an efficient method to manage client enrolment and submit the enrolment data to the Home Clinic Repository.

What are the prerequisites to get this service?

You must be an active Home Clinic and have a Certified EMR Product that has achieved additional certification to the Enrolment Service. How does it work?

A Digital Solutions Facilitator will work with the site to enable its interface and the Home Clinic Liaisons will provide an orientation and prepare you for the go-live.

This service is provisioned at the clinic EMR level. Configuration is done by the EMR Vendor support and enabled by Digital Health.

Benefits of the Enrolment Service

- Improved accuracy and timelines of enrolment.
- Fewer enrolment rejections.
- Timely validation of enrolment data errors within the EMR.
- Up-to-date remediation notifications of conflicts in enrolment data delivered directly to the EMR.
- Discontinued manual entry in Home Clinic Portal to update enrolment records for clinics with shared EMRs.
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
