Prevent Patient Harm

Preventing patient falls is a safety priority.

All health care workers play a part in falls prevention.



NEW Falls Prevention Strategy*

- 1) Have universal fall precautions in place on admission
- 2) Complete Fall Risk Assessment Tool within 24-48 hours of admission*
- 3) Individualize Resident Care Plan quarterly based on risk & after any fall
 - 4) Educate residents/families on fall prevention, risk & interventions
 - 5) Participate in falls prevention education for staff & volunteers

Common Falls Prevention Interventions

- Falls risk assessment & history prior to admission
- Assess pain, elimination, thirst, call bell, vision, cognition, mobility
- Look at environment & reduce hazards, e.g., bed is at appropriate height
- L Lying & sitting/standing BP
- **S** Show/orient resident/family to surroundings



Communication & Documentation

- Document the resident risk & plans for prevention
- Communicate the resident risk to other staff
- Document the effectiveness of the plan

Evaluation
