

## Infection Prevention and Control Fundamentals for Redeployed and Deployed Staff to Long Term Care Sites

For individuals redeployed/deployed to a site requiring IP&C orientation, utilize SDO/regional and Shared Health educational resources as outlined below:

Note: If re-deployed staff member is not already designated a 'Direct Care Worker' they shall be re-evaluated, prior to re-deployment, to determine if they now fit the definition of 'Direct Care Worker'.

- Staff, visitor and volunteer screening
- Visitation principles document(s)

## Glossary:

<u>Deployment</u>: The assignment of an employee to PCH. Staff hired into the Shared Health COVID19 Resource Pool are deployed (assigned) to areas of need. Employees can be deployed to more than one site. An employee can be deployed to AIA and PCH or to immunization and PCH, etc. Employment is limited to the period of the pandemic. There are casual and term positions.

<u>Reassignment</u>: The movement of an employee within the scope of the Collective Agreement, to a different unit or worksite. In the PCH context this would mean moving someone from one unit to another unit in the same PCH.

<u>Redeployment</u>: The movement of an employee to a different site either within or between employers or a third party.

## Examples:

- moving an employee from Community to provide support in a PCH.
- moving an employee from a hospital to provide support in a PCH.
- moving an employee from PCH A to PCH B.
