

## RL – Reporting Violence

## **QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE**

RL will be used to report any type of violence or aggression between clients, or by clients toward staff.

<u>Staff injuries as a result of a safety event must also be reported using your Health</u> Authority's workplace health and safety reporting process.


Note: Consult your Health Authority Leadership for support with reporting any concerns related to client harm caused by staff. Other types of reporting may be required including:

- Protection for Persons in Care Office (PPCO) reporting, which can be accessed at this link: Report Abuse/Neglect | PPCO | Health | Province of Manitoba (gov.mb.ca)
- Child Abuse or Neglect: contact Child and Family Services (CFS)

## To report violence in RL:

Access RL and select the blue **Security/Safety** Icon on the Icon Wall.

Note: If you type the keywords "violence" or "assault" into the Find a Form text box, it will show the Security/Safety Icon.




## RL – Reporting Violence

Enter the safety event details into the form. The **Type of Person Affected** field should be completed for the person who experienced the violence.



If certain fields are selected such as Abuse/Assault, Theft or Collision, a new section called **Actions By** will be visible. Indicate who acted out or caused the safety event to occur.
