# SAFE SURGERY CHECKLIST

Note: Patient/Client/Resident used interchangeably



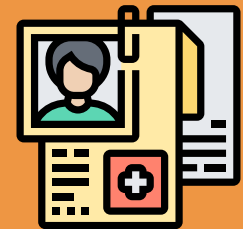
## Prevent Patient Harm

Using a safe surgery checklist can reduce preventable patient injury and improve surgical outcomes for the patient.

## Use a Safe Surgery Checklist

Your surgical team must:

- Use a three phase surgical checklist for every surgery done in the operating room (O.R.)
- Document completion of list in patient record



## Three Phases

### 1) 'Briefing' - before induction of anesthesia

Items checked in this phase may include:

- Risk of blood loss has been identified
- Surgical site has been marked
- Pre-op antibiotics have been ordered?



### 2) 'Time Out' - before skin incision

Items checked in this phase may include:

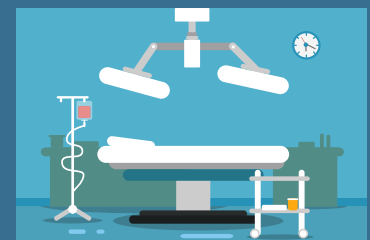
- Confirm right patient, procedure & site
- Diagnostic images & /or reports available
- Time out - any questions from the team?



### 3) 'Debriefing' - before patient leaves O.R.

Items checked in this phase may include:

- Instrument, sponge & needle count
- Review any intra-operative events
- Recovery & management plans



## Evaluation

The use of the checklist is evaluated. The results shared with the team, and used to make improvements.
