Steps to be taken to complete task safely:

1 Unlock the main access door using the scanner, keyboard or keys.



When opening the access door, use a wide base of support.



- 3 Place the linen cart a few steps away from the ScrubEx Medium Dispenser.
- From the linen cart, take one scrub top and bottom of necessary size, roll the scrubs together and place into appropriate slot. Get as close as possible to the ScrubEx Medium Volume Dispenser when loading.





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- If necessary, use a step stool when placing scrubs into slots that are located over shoulder height. When loading the lower compartments below waist level, bend at the hips and knees and keep the back straight.
- 6 Once all compartments have been loaded, close the door using a wide base of support.

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Steps to be taken to complete task safely when removing/unloading soiled scrubs from the ScrubEx Medium Volume Dispenser Receiver

Open the service doors using the keys by bending at the hips and knees and keep the back straight.
If needed, kneel on one knee.





Using a half kneel position weight shift from the front leg to the back leg when sliding the receiver bin out.





Maintaining a wide base of support, bending at the hips and knees, and keeping your back straight, lift the bin and empty the soiled scrubs into the laundry cage. Place the receiver bin back into the ScrubEx Medium Volume Dispenser Receiver.
