VISUAL MANAGEMENT




Visual management is a workplace organization methodology used to create, maintain, monitor, and improve a well-organized, clean, safe, and highly productive work area. Refer to the 5S one-pager for more specifics on that methodology.

Visual management:

- Reduces the non-value-added time spent searching and walking around to find items
- Reduces process delays caused by searching
- Helps control inventory levels to the optimal level
- Makes it so anyone can understand what to do

- Direction of traffic
- Rules for navigation
- Safe and unsafe places to store items
