Patient Instructionsfor **Urine Collection**

Your care provider has asked for a urine sample.

A clean-catch midstream collection is a method of obtaining a urine sample free of most germs that are normally found in the skin of your urinary area.



Clean-Catch Midstream Collection





Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water. Dry hands.







WOMEN: Keep legs apart and hold the skin folds (labia) apart and first pass a small amount of urine into the toilet

before moving the container into the stream of urine. Fill the container halfway to two-thirds full.




MEN: Retract the foreskin and first pass a small amount of urine into the toilet before moving the container into the stream of urine. Fill the container halfway to two-thirds full.

Releasing a small amount of urine into the toilet prevents bacteria that normally resides in the urinary area from contaminating your sample.



You may finish emptying your bladder directly into the toilet.







Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water.

Please place sample in designated cabinet or deliver sample to appropriate personnel as instructed.
