## **HEPARIN INDUCED THROMBOCYTOPENIA (HIT) TESTING**

### **CHANGE IN SPECIMEN REQUIREMENT**

**Date Effective: Immediately** 

Date Issued: July 4, 2018

## **Change in or New Test Procedure:**

The McMaster Platelet Immunology Laboratory has made changes in their HIT testing protocol and sample requirements. Therefore, additional collection of blood/tubes will be needed, should the result of our local test be positive or indeterminate.

**ALL** the following tubes **must** be obtained for comprehensive testing:

Serum: 1 red top 10 mL tube (at least 2/3 full)

Plasma: 3 light blue 1.8 mL Sodium Citrate tubes

These requirements will be re-assessed once the new local HIT testing method is implemented.
