# **Clinical Practice Change Alert**

## **Revision to Regional Reference Laboratories for** 24-Hour INR Testing Process

#### **Date Effective:** Immediately

### **Summary of Information:**

DSM has been providing 24- hour TAT for INR tests for routine monitoring patients on long term warfarin and other non-urgent use at many sites across Manitoba (See link below for DSM Clinical Practice Change dated April 20, 2016). Alternatively, patients can choose to visit a regional reference laboratory that can accommodate same day test results. The list of potential regional reference laboratories has been modified since it was initially issued in April 2016.

### **Change and Patient Impact:**

- There is no change in procedure for 24-hour TAT for INR tests for routine • monitoring or noted exceptions where expedited results will be available.
