# Influenza/RSV PCR Testing in Shared Health Clinical **Microbiology Laboratories**

Date effective: April 20, 2020

## **Background Information:**

Influenza is a seasonal illness. In North America, influenza season occurs in the fall and winter with peak activity between December and February. Current influenza positivity rates in Manitoba and Canada are <1%. Routine testing of outpatients for influenza at this time, including emergency room patients who will not be admitted to hospital, is not the best use of our limited resources. This temporary change in laboratory testing practice will permit Shared Health Clinical Microbiology Laboratories to focus their molecular testing resources on COVID-19.

## Change in Test Procedure:

- Influenza/RSV PCR testing at Shared Health Clinical Microbiology Laboratories will temporarily be restricted to confirmed hospital in-patients only.
- Only samples for influenza/RSV PCR testing received on an original CPL requisition will be accepted by Shared Health Clinical Microbiology Laboratories. Photocopied CPL requisitions will not be accepted.
