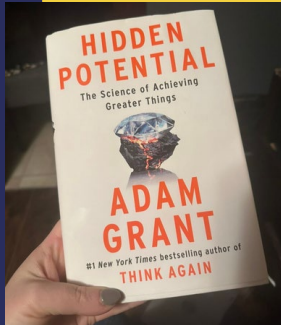

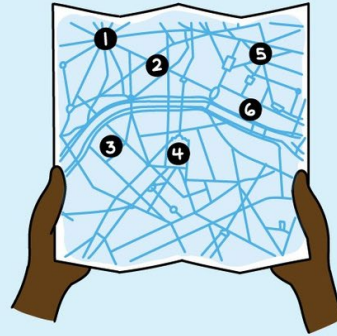

What Did We Hear Today Reality Check

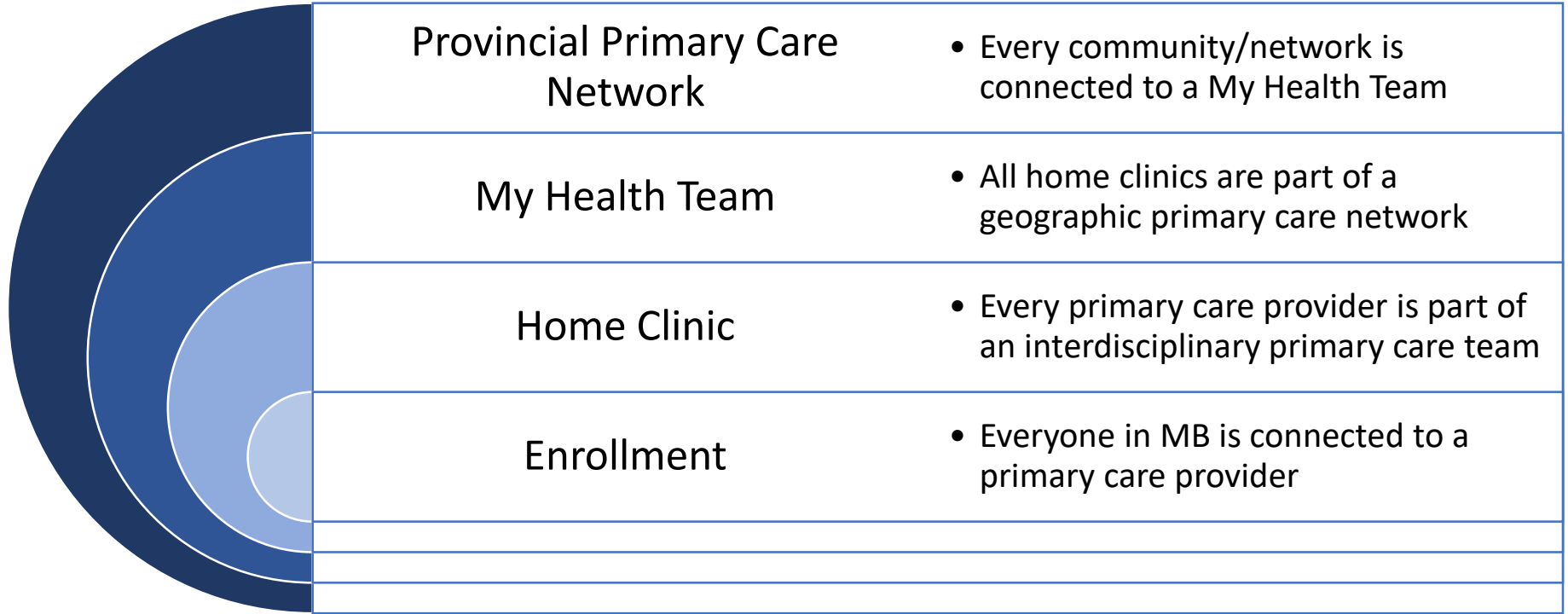


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We have gaps in enrollment, access, health and human resource challenges, system integration (technology, clinics, programs etc.), communication
