Getting ready for Accreditation using "Mini-Tracers"

This 90 minute instructor led virtual session provides an overview of how to use "Mini-Tracers" in preparing for Accreditation.

A Tracer is the method Accreditation Canada surveyors use to evaluate both clinical (direct care) and administrative (governance, leadership, management) processes during an on-site visit.
