As you likely are aware, Manitoba's Unions Representing Community and Facility Support Workers throughout much of the province have issued Strike Notice with an effective date of October 8, 2024 at 6:00 a.m.

While talks continue, planning is underway to limit disruption to our patients, residents and clients in the event of a work stoppage.

Essential Service Agreements are being reviewed in each affected area, with the primary goal of limiting disruption and maintaining essential health services.

We understand you will have many questions about what this potential work stoppage may mean for patients, residents and clients as well as for your role and work. We are committed to keeping you informed as information is available.

In the coming days, more information will be shared with you, including more detailed information about preparations underway and the anticipated impact to non-essential services.
