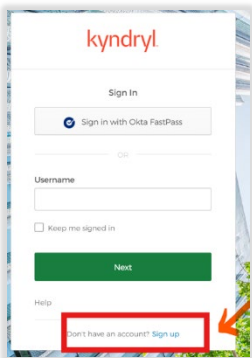
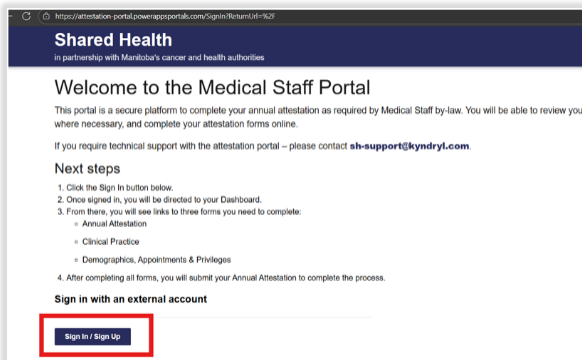


Shared Health Attestation Portal Self-Registration Guide: Initial Sign Up

1. Go to <https://attestation-portal.powerappsportals.com> on your desktop/laptop browser & click on **Sign up**

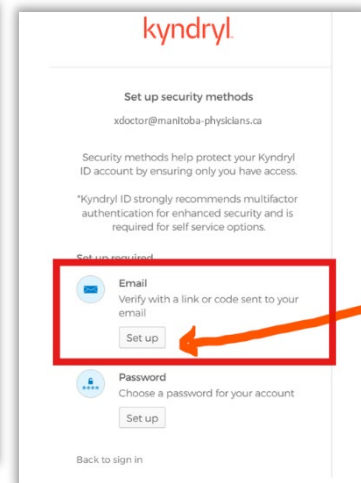
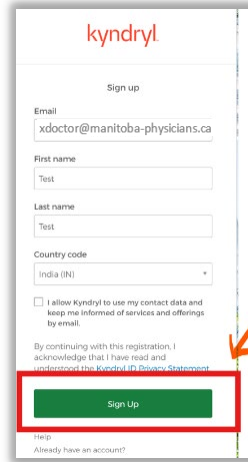

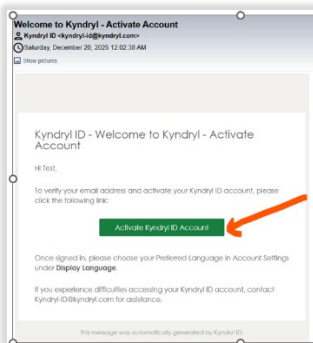
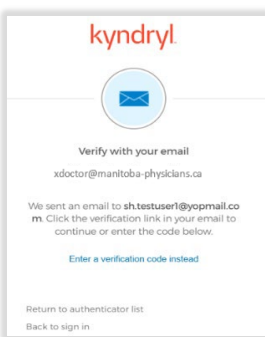
2. Enter Email, Name, Country → Sign Up → Set up email security

Your email should be your primary health authority issued or Manitoba-physicians email address, which will then become your username. This email is linked to your active work email.

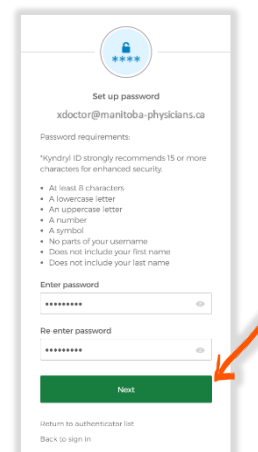
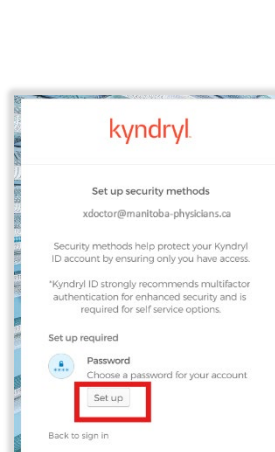

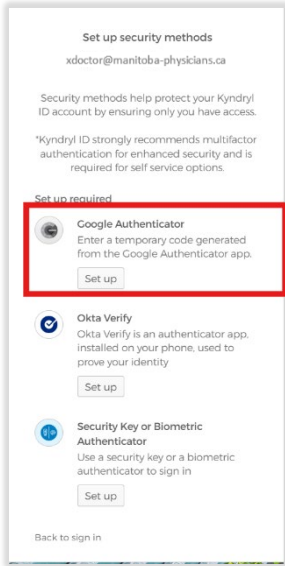
3. Check email (your active email) → Activate within 5 minutes



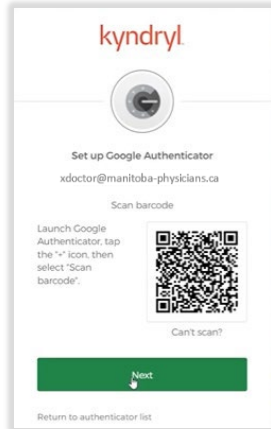
4. Set Password -> Confirm



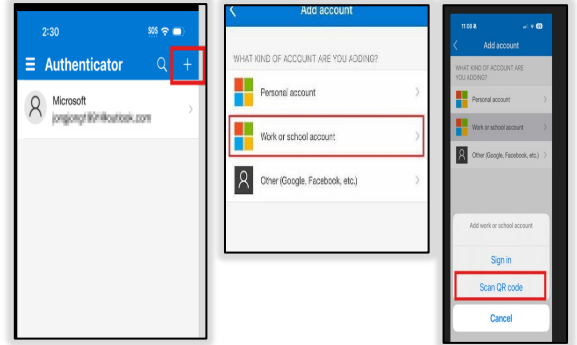
5. Select Google Authenticator option. This option works for Microsoft Authenticator too.



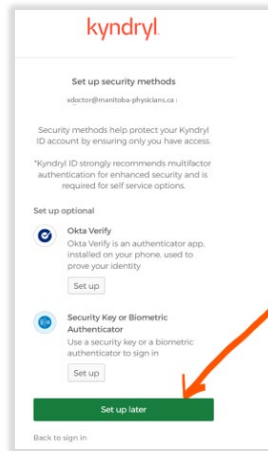
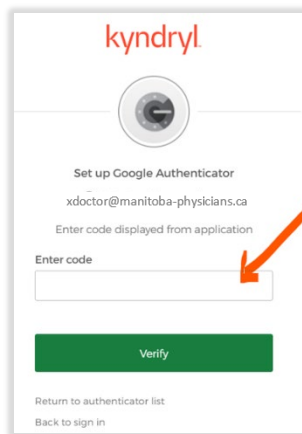
6. You will see the QR code below.



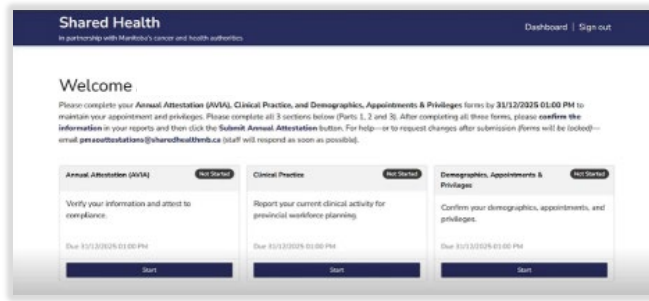
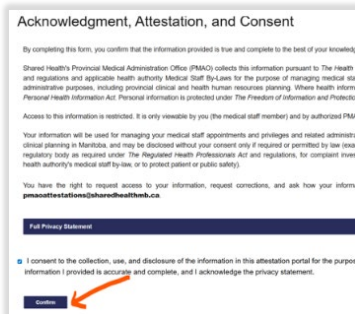
7. Open the Microsoft Authenticator App on your mobile device and press the plus (+) to add new account.



8. Scan the QR code with the Microsoft Authenticator → Enter the code, verify, and click on 'Set up later'.




9. Done! You are signed up and can click consent to continue to attestation.








